#### How to become an Approved Exporter

- Written application to CCO
- Accompanied by an information questionnaire
- Check by the CCO based on the information questionnaire
- Considerations of the risks
- On site verification
- Granting or not of the Approved Exporter status





#### Information Questionnaire

- What kind of company?
- Responsible persons?
- Education of the responsible persons?
- Special procedures like processing traffic?
- Suppliers?





#### Information Questionnaire

- Value addition in Switzerland?
- Processes taking place in Switzerland?
- Procedure/way to judge the origin
- Number of exports?
- Countries of destination?
- How to maintain origin knowledge?





#### (Periodical) Checks

- Obligation to inform CCO of any relevant changes
- CCO verifies these information
- Information questionnaire has to be renewed at least every 4 years





#### Withdrawal of the Authorisation

- Conditions are no more fulfilled
- Lack of co-operation
- Loss of reliability towards the customs administration





#### **General Remarks**

- Providing courses concerning origin matters
- Providing an e-learning course
- Switzerland has currently 2'400 Approved Exporters





(Iceland)

- Implementing provisions and guidelines revised with effect from 1 February 2007
- New number system: 0123-IS10
- All holders of authorisations had to apply for renewed approval
- Around 70% applied for a new number straight away





(Iceland)

- Authorisation is normally granted for 5 years at a time.
- In specific cases, authorisation can be granted for one year, after which the company needs to re-apply. If all is in order, a 5 year authorisation is granted





(Iceland)

- The companies keep the number they were granted it does not change with renewal, i.e. an authorisation granted in 2010, which is renewed in 2015 keeps the number 0123-IS10
- Customs authorities can control an authorised company at any time





(Norway)

- •To receive the status of an Approved Exporter, applicants have to:
  - complete an application form;
  - show that they know and understand the rules of origin;
  - undertake responsibility for the way the authorisation is used
  - fill in a questionnaire providing information concerning:
    - · their goods,
    - the proofs of origin,
    - · the rules of origin,
    - · their suppliers, and
    - how they are able to prove the originating status of the exported goods.
  - keep all documentary proof of origin for a period of at least three years
  - allow inspections by customs authorities at any time.





(Norway)

- First time applicants authorisation is granted for 2 years
- After 2 years If positive result, authorisation is granted for 5 years
- The regional customs authorities are obliged to control an authorised company:
  - at least once during the first 2-year (trial) period; and
  - at least two times during each 5-year period






### Authorisation Number

- Format of the Norwegian authorisation number





#### **Approved Exporters**

Updated: 4/16/2014 Case number: 2013/28940

Under certain conditions an exporter may make out invoice declarations and invoice declarations EUR-MED irrespective of the value of the products concerned.

Norwegian Customs Authorities may authorize any exporter (hereafter referred to as Approved Exporter) who makes frequent shipments of products under Free Trade Agreements in which the Approved Exporter arrangement is effective.

The list of Approved Exporters is published on this site and shall apply under the EFTA Convention, all EFTA Free Trade Agreements and the following FTAs:

- Authorisation should be hard to get
- Authorisation are easier to loose
- The local customs authorities are required to improve their controls of companies holding an authorisation by regular controls of their systems and their knowledge and application of the rules of origin and other relevant provisions
