

**ANNEX 3A**  
**PRODUCT SPECIFIC RULES (PSR)**

**Headnotes**

1. For interpreting the rules of origin in the table of the Product Specific Rules of this Annex:
  - (a) **HS Code** means the tariff classification number as set out in the HS<sup>1</sup>;
  - (b) **Section** means the sections as set out in the HS;
  - (c) **Chapter** means the first two digits of the tariff classification number as set out in the HS;
  - (d) **Heading** means the first four digits of the tariff classification number as set out in the HS;
  - (e) **Subheading** means the first six digits of the tariff classification number as set out in the HS.
2. The table of the Product Specific Rules is set out as follows:
  - (a) Column 1 – HS Code (heading or subheading)
  - (b) Column 2 – Good description, as set out in the HS
  - (c) Column 3 – Product Specific Rules of Origin
  - (d) Column 4 – Alternative Product-Specific Rules of Origin
3. Where a rule is specified in columns 3 and 4, the exporter or producer may apply either the rule set out in column 3 or 4.
4. Where, in some cases, the entry in the first column is preceded by an 'ex', this signifies that the rules in column 3 or 4 apply only to the part of that heading or subheading as described in column 2.
5. Where a product specific rule of origin requires that the materials used undergo a change in tariff classification or a specific working or processing operation, the rules shall apply only to non-originating materials.

6. Where a product specific rule of origin is defined using the criterion of a change in tariff classification, the rule will be considered to be met only if each of the non-originating materials used in the production of the good has undergone the required change in tariff classification.
7. If a product specific rule of origin is defined by a criterion of change in tariff classification that is accompanied by the expression “except”, it shall be construed to mean that the product specific rule of origin requires the excluded materials to be originating for the good to be originating.
8. For the purposes of column 3 and 4:
  - (a) The expression “**all the materials of Chapter (..) are wholly obtained (WO)**” means that the said materials must satisfy the wholly obtained or produced criteria in accordance with Article 3.3 (Wholly Obtained Goods);
  - (b) **CC (Change in Chapter)** means that all non-originating materials used in the production of the good have undergone a change in tariff classification at the 2-digit level;
  - (c) **CTH (Change in Tariff Heading)** means that all non-originating materials used in the production of the good have undergone a change in tariff classification at the 4-digit level;
  - (d) **CTSH (Change in Tariff Sub-Heading)** means that all non-originating materials used in the production of the good have undergone a change in tariff classification at the 6-digit level;
  - (e) **QVC** means Qualifying Value Content as per paragraph 3 of Article 3.4 (Sufficient Working or Processing);
  - (f) **N/A** means no rules are applicable.

9. Note to Chapter 3:

The fish, crustaceans, molluscs, and other aquatic invertebrates shall be deemed originating even if they were cultivated from non-originating fry or larvae. “Fry” means immature fish at a post-larval stage, including fingerlings, parr, smolts, and elvers.

10. Note to Section II (Chapters 6-14):

Agricultural and horticultural goods grown in the territory of a Party shall be treated as originating in the territory of that Party even if grown from seeds, bulbs, rootstock, cuttings, grafts, shoots, buds, or other live parts of plants imported from

a non-party.
