Instructions how to fill out Certificate of Origin VIFTA

The instructions below apply to both electronic and paper Certificates of Origin.

Box No. 1 – “Exporter”

This box shall bear the details of the exporter, its name and its address in the exporting country.

Box No. 2 – “Certificate No.”

This box is for the use of the issuing authority, which shall fill in the certificate number.

Box No. 3 – “Importer” (Optional)

This box shall bear the details of the importer of the goods in the country of final destination.

Box No. 4 – “Country of Origin”

This box shall bear the name of the country where the goods obtained their originating status.

Box No. 5 – “Port of shipment and Transport Details” (Optional)

This box shall indicate the port of shipment from Vietnam or from Israel.

Box No. 6 – “Country of Destination”

This box shall bear the name of the country which is the final destination of the goods.

Box No. 7 – “Observations”

This box shall bear observations made by the issuing authority, for example, the mention “DUPLICATE”, “ISSUED RETROSPECTIVELY”, etc.

Box No. 8 – “Commercial Invoices” (Optional)

This box shall bear the number of the invoices that are covered by the certificate.

Box No. 9 – “Description of the goods”

This box shall bear a detailed description of all the goods covered by the certificate. The description of the goods must be sufficiently detailed to enable the goods to be identified by the Customs Officers examining them as much as possible.

In the field named “No.”, the row number of the goods (index) will be written.

For goods that meet the origin criteria, the exporter and/or producer must indicate the origin criteria met, in the manner shown in the following table:

(a) The goods wholly obtained or produced in a Party	“WO”
(b) The goods obtained in a Party incorporating materials which have not been wholly obtained there, provided that such materials have undergone sufficient working or processing in a Party within the meaning of Article 3.5 (Sufficiently Worked or Processed Goods).	“PSR”
(c) The goods obtained in a Party exclusively from materials that qualify as originating pursuant to Chapter 3 (Rules of Origin).	“PE”

Lack of correspondence between the origin criteria detailed on the certificate and the actual origin criteria shall not in itself constitute a reason for voiding the certificate.

In the field reserved for the gross weight or other quantity – the gross weight or any other units of quantity of the goods shall be detailed.

Box No. 10 – “Declaration”

The exporter shall indicate in the proper field whether or not he is the producer. If the exporter is also the producer of the goods covered by the certificate, he shall mark the box "Producer". If not, he shall mark the box "Exporter".

Box No. 11 – "Certification"

This box shall bear the details of the issuing authority, and shall be signed and stamped by that authority.
